

## MICROMORPHOLOGICAL STUDIES OF CISSUS QUADRANGULARIS L.-AN IMPORTANT MEDICINAL PLANT

ABSTRACT: The micromorphological and anatomical studies of *Cissus quadrangularis* L. (Family Vitaceae) were conducted using both preserved material (maintained in 4% formaldehyde solution) and fresh field collections. The examination of the internal structure yielded significant findings. This study represents the first detailed report on the internal anatomy, dermatology, and vessel structure of *Cissus quadrangularis*. Previous efforts have not attempted to identify or critically evaluate the internal structure and micromorphology of this species. This study aims to fill that gap by systematically collecting and documenting authentic information regarding the plant's micromorphology, botany, microscopy, and pharmacology. Such comprehensive documentation is expected to enhance the understanding of the therapeutic and scientific potential of *C. quadrangularis*, contributing to future research and applications in the field.
