ABOUT THE COURSE

This training program covers the range of topics related to soil sampling and testing. It comprises of introductory sessions on importance of soil testing and hands on experience in soil, water and plant analysis using modern tools and equipment. The training modules are designed to equip the participants in analysing physical and chemical properties of soil, water and plant analysis.

- Physical properties Bulk density, soil colour, soil moisture, infiltration rate and soil texture.
- Chemical properties pH, electrical conductivity, macro and micro nutrients and heavy metals
- Water analysis Colour, silica content, Chromium and Fluoride content.
- Plant analysis Macro and Micronutrients.



Along with this, training will be given in interpreting the soil results and preparing soil health cards.
